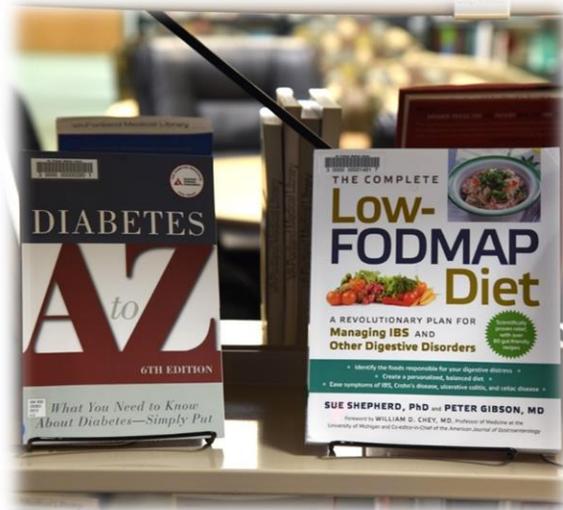

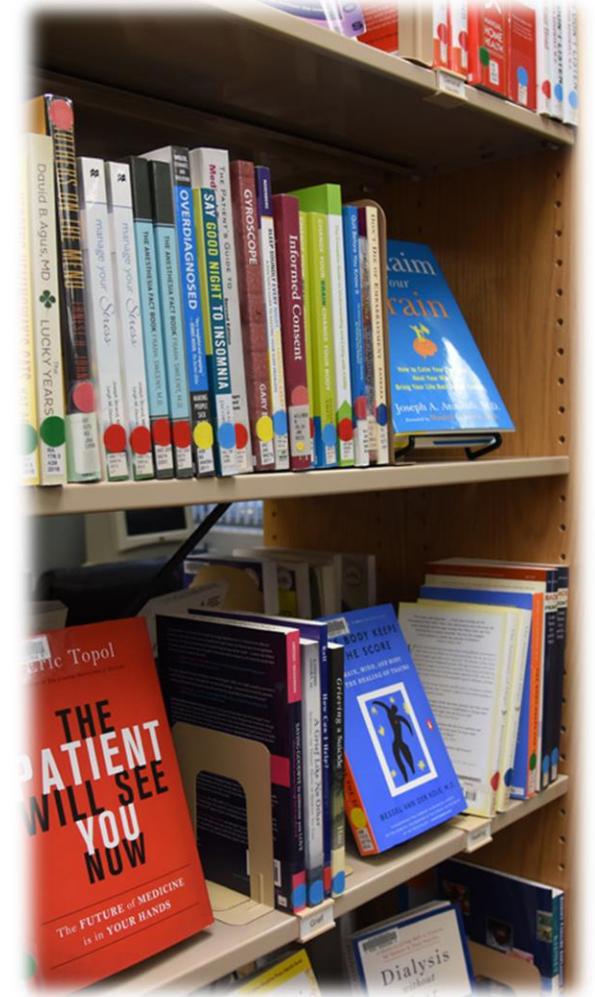
The library serves as a resource for medical staff, patients, and family members. Library staff can assist in finding information on a wide variety of health topics.

The library offers computers for internet access, as well as health books that can be checked out. Fiction books (no check-out needed), magazines, and comfortable chairs in a quiet space are also available.
