1) It is ok to give money or gifts to my living donor and/or their family.		
2) Kidney transplant is a cure.		
3) It is up to me to let my transplant coordinator know when I complete my "to do" list.		
4) If I decide not to take my medications or show up for dialysis it will not affect whether I am offered a donor kidney.		
5) It is my responsibility to send in blood tubes every 28 days.		
6) There are multiple donor options for me to consider. For example, I can choose to accept an organ offer from a Hepatitis C positive donor.		
7) The average time spent on the waitlist depends on many factors (blood type, tissue typing, dialysis time). Historically, the average wait times have been 3-5 years if transplant is from a deceased donor. A living donor transplant allows for a much shorter wait time.		
8) Immunosuppression medications increase my risk of cancer, infection, and heart disease.		
9) Following my clinic, lab, and medication schedule is my responsibility after transplant to avoid rejecting my new organ.		
10) I can be listed at more than one transplant center.
